


BEST KNOWN FOR ITS COLORFUL LOCAL CHARACTER AND RICH LITERARY HISTORY,

Send-Off Breakfast on the Sunset Deck



Intimate Weddings & Vow Renewals





The Pier



Sunset Deck

The Sunset Deck, elevated above The Pier on a private roof deck of Bistro 245 (Opal Key Resort & Marina's signature restaurant), was designed with an eye toward elegance. Unobstructed ocean views and the ideal vantage point for the daily Sunset Celebration are all the decoration you'll need, or you can add festival lighting to bring the dance floor to life. Inspired by Key West's colorful "conch home" architecture, there's also a built-in bar, so your guests won't have to stray far from the fun.


